I have a cheeky dachshund called Banjo, a white lopped eared bunny called Molly and 3 chickens.



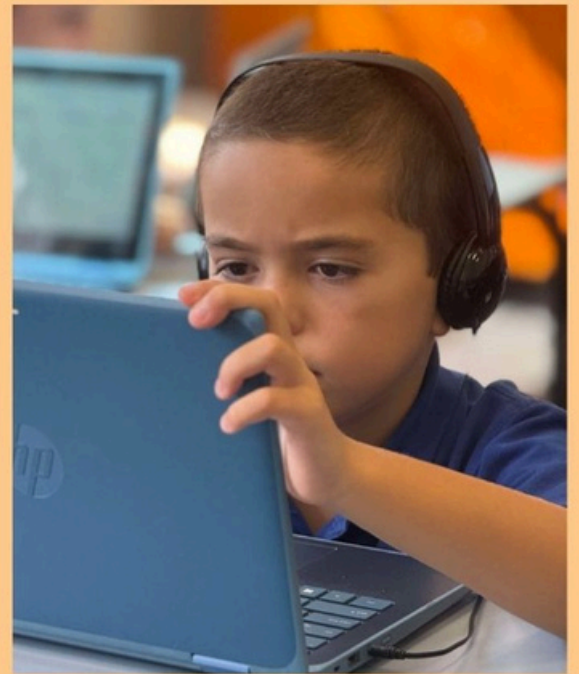
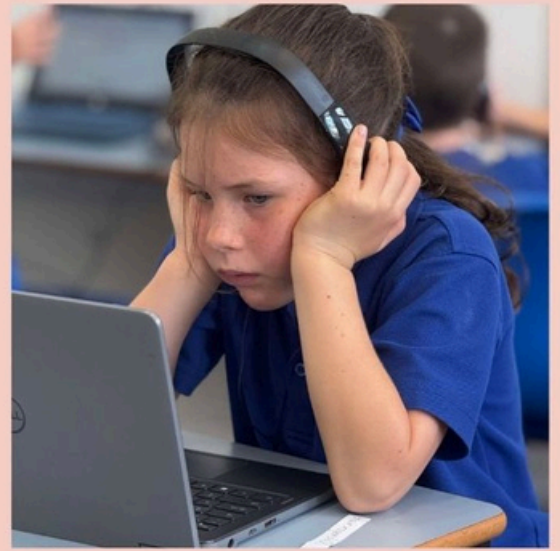
### MY FAVORITES

- ✿ Not so much a favourite food but I love my Dad's cooking! He makes the best curries and cooks the best fresh fish. If coffee were a food, it would also make the list

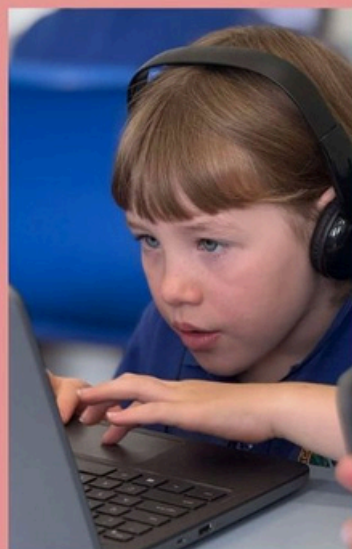
