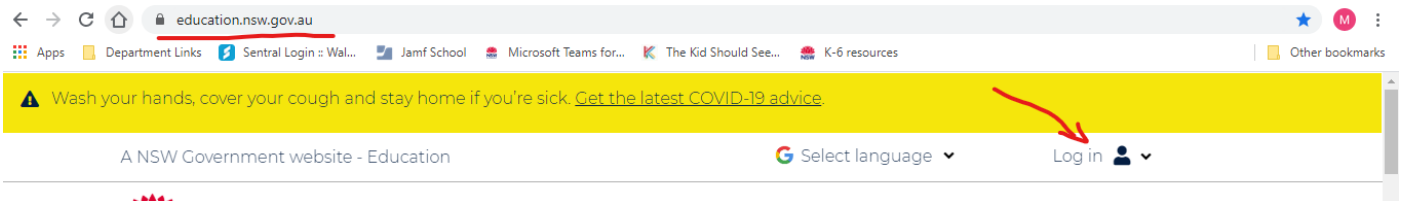


How to join a Student Google Classroom

1. Go to www.education.nsw.gov.au
2. Click Log in and Select Student Portal



3. Enter Student UserID and Password.

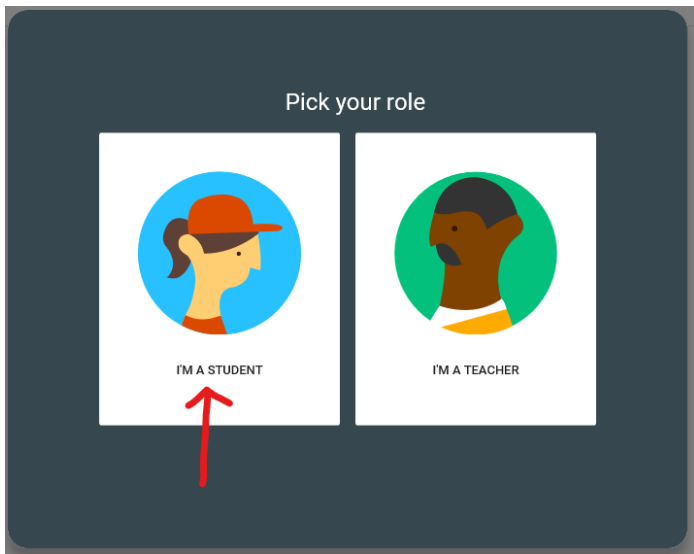
5. Select "G Suite Google Apps for Classroom"

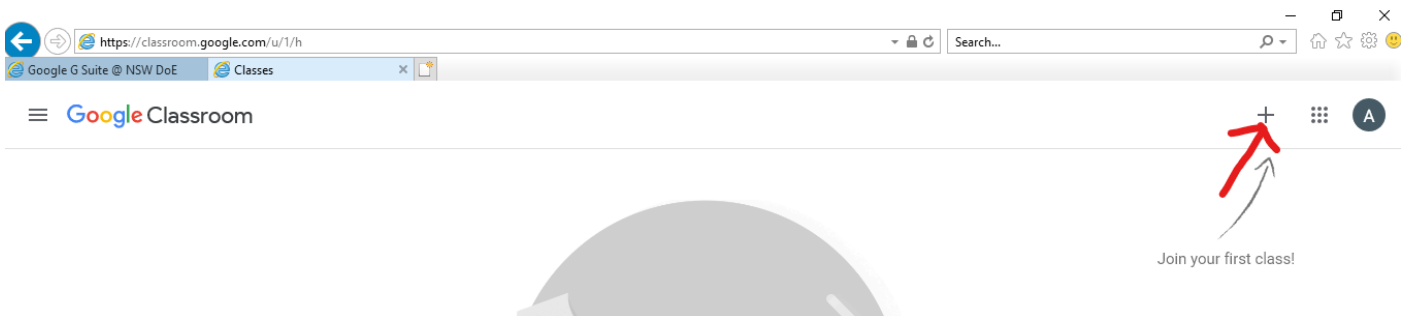
6. Select "Google Classroom"

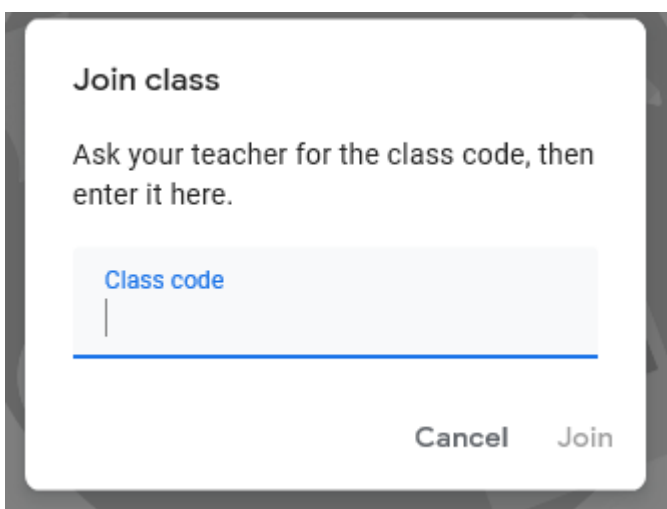
7. If this is the first time you have used Google Classroom then you will need to accept the User Agreement. Select “I’m a Student”



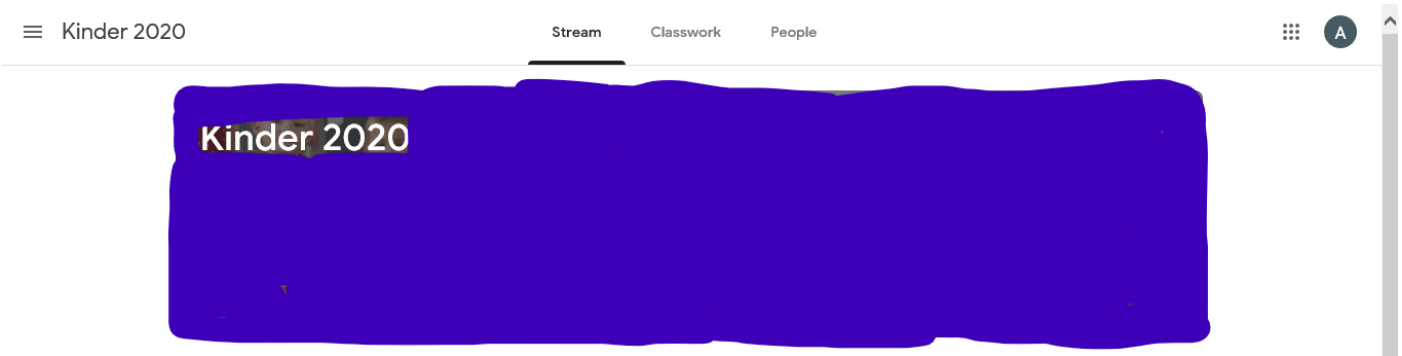
8. Click the Plus button in the top Right Hand Corner
